

RESPONSES FROM BRENDAN BUNYAN - KAP

1. Q: Do you support companies developing new thermal and metallurgical coal mines in Australia?

A: Yes we support all industry advancement for Australia. People need to remember that metallurgical coal is used for the manufacturing of steel.
